la la	2 E	Electronic security arrangement: The Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India has taken proactive steps to beef up CCTV Surveillance and gadget based electronic security in VMH. One baggage scanner & eight (8) Door Frame Metal Detectors (DFMD) are in operation at the entry point of VMH. 40 CCTV Cameras have already been installed and are in working condition. More than 200 additional cameras are due to be installed very soon. The Ministry of Culture has provided adequate fund for this purpose.
