Young Minds for a Compassionate World is an exhibition growing out of a landmark collaboration between the Victoria Memorial Hall and the Natural History Museum, London, to train young students of Bengal in ethical nature photography, with a view to documenting the impact of climate change on biodiversity. Supported entirely by the British Council as a part of the **India/UK Together, a Season of Culture**, it is a flagship project of nurturing young students as climate ambassadors in this critical time of climate breakdown, biodiversity loss, habitat destruction, and disease outbreak. This exhibition showcases the work of 33 students in the age range from 15 to 22, mentored by some of the most eminent nature photographers in India.
